Why support the \$6.4 million S Washington St Bus Stop Expansion and Access to Transit Project?

1. **Enhance Multimodal Connectivity:** Enhance connections to City and County businesses, recreational, and cultural destinations.
2. **Increase Safety and Accessibility:** Increase accessibility and safety for pedestrians and transit riders.
3. **Relieve Congestion:** Relieve congestion on area streets and highways by increasing travel options.

What's in the S Washington St Bus Stop Expansion and Access to Transit Project application?

The project runs along South Washington Street, between Maple Avenue and Graham Road, at the City boundary line. The project will install six new bus shelters, install crosswalks and pedestrian refuge areas, and upgrade one traffic signal. The project includes adjustments to intersection geometry and improved ramps. Associated right of way and utilities are also included in the project scope.


